

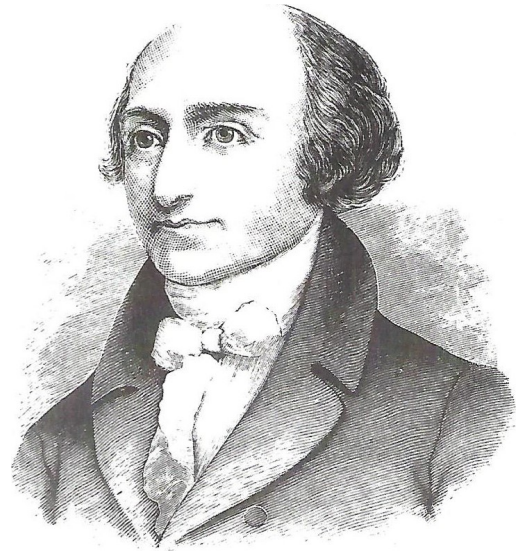

Set at Gallatin's Pennsylvania estate in New Geneva, FestiFall draws guests from the surrounding area as well as travelers from West Virginia, Maryland, and Ohio.
